



Smithville Rotary Club 2020 Merit Badge College Registration

February 1, 2020



Who: Registered Scouts and their leaders are invited to attend. All units must be under the supervision of at least two adult leaders of the age of 21 or older at all times during the event. One additional leader is required for every five boys over ten. If you are attending with only your son, we will accept a registration of one scout and a parent. Any registrations not in compliance with this requirement will be returned.

What: Community leaders will staff the merit badge classes. These specially approved counselors will provide training and facilitate advancement on merit badges using the requirement and standards offered by the Boy Scouts of America in their most recent revision.

A Boy Scout is prepared. Scouts will receive confirmation of their enrollment on or before December 31, 2019. This confirmation will include detailed prerequisite information for badge work that must be completed and delivered to the counselor at the event for credit. **Being prepared mean the scout attends the class and participates fully, including the completion of any advance work requested. Complete merit badge signoff is not guaranteed at the college.** Credit can only be awarded for work completed in class if they do not bring prerequisite work with them that day. Badge work can be completed with a qualified District counselor after the event, if necessary. **Scouts must bring a blue merit badge card signed by unit leader for each merit badge. No merit badge card will be provided by the counselor.**

Eagle required badges may be limited to those who enroll early. We will make every attempt to manage the popularity of these badges by honoring just one Eagle required badge per scout until all registrations have been processed. However, there is no guarantee that scouts will get into Eagle required badge classes. Spaces are limited and classes close when filled. We appreciate your understanding and support of this policy.

When/Where: On Saturday, February 1, 2020 at the Smithville, MO Middle School (675 S Commercial Ave, Smithville, MO 64089). Check-in begins at 7:30 AM and is done by troop. The troop leader should be the one to check-in. Opening and announcements is at 8:00 AM. Scouts will be dismissed from the opening by merit badge. Morning classes run from 8:30-11:30 AM. Lunch will be provided from 11:30-12:00. Afternoon classes run from 12:00-3:00 PM. Please be prompt. The event will end by 3:00 PM.

Why: This program is organized by the Smithville Rotary Club as a service to the community. The money raised from this event will be used to provide scholarships and fund other service projects undertaken by the club.

Costs: The registration fee is \$25 per scout and \$5 per adult leader. Registrations should be returned prior to October 31 to ensure priority. Late registration fees after October 31, 2019 will be \$30 per scout and \$10 per leader. No walk-ins will be allowed. Registration is on a first come first served basis and must be paid in advance. This inclusive fee covers the cost of the event, lunch and use of the facilities for badge work, program supplies, classroom materials and event production needs. Some badges may have a small additional material fee as noted in the list. Preregistration is required for each unit.

Specials Needs: If any member of your group has any special needs, please inform us. We need your help to "be prepared" and provide reasonable accommodation for a successful and enjoyable experience.

Uniform: Class A uniform is required for all scouts. Leaders are encouraged to also wear the Class A uniform.

Leaders/Adults: All leaders and adults, including parents attending with their scout, in attendance are encouraged to have completed BSA Youth Protection. If you have not completed Youth Protection, please go to www.scouting.org to complete it. **We ask that all leaders and parents attend merit badge classes with their scouts to provide additional insight and assistance in instructing and supervising scouts.**
